**TEACH Grant Application**

This application must be completed in order to be considered for the Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program. This grant provides up to \$4,000 per year (\$16,000 total for 4-year undergraduate and \$8,000 total for graduate programs).

To receive this grant, you must teach full-time in a high-need subject area for at least four years in a school that serves students from low-income families.

Failure to meet this service requirement will result in this grant being converted to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan, which is subject to repayment.

<p>I understand that the TEACH Grant program has specific obligations that must be met in order for the award to remain a grant. If I fail to meet all of the conditions of the award or if the conditions are not documented as required, I understand that the award will permanently convert to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan and that I will be responsible to repay this loan with interest calculated from the disbursement date of the grant. I understand that once a TEACH Grant is converted to a loan, it cannot be converted back to a grant.</p>
